Appetitt Kitten is rich in protein from animal and marine ingredients. Its high protein digestibility and essential amino acid content are adapted for growing kittens up to approx. 1 year of age. The high energy and nutritional content means that Appetitt Kitten is also suitable during gestation and lactation. With the exception of rice, the food is grain free and high in hydrolysed proteins. Thus, the food is low in ingredients that can lead to intolerance and allergies.

Natural glucosamine and chondroitin from salmon and chicken for joint and bone health.

Furthermore, Appetitt Kitten contains Antarctic krill, providing your kitten with the vital omega-3 fatty acids, EPA and DHA in the form of phospholipids. Ideal ratio of omega-3/omega-6 fatty acids and a high content of vitamin E and rosemary for your kitten's joints, skin, coat and overall health. Fructo-oligosaccharides (FOS) from beet fibre for your kitten's gastrointestinal health. Contains beta-glucans from yeast for the overall health of your kitten. Appetitt Kitten contain natural antioxidants such as vitamin E and rosemary.

Appetitt Kitten is also suitable for neutered and sterilised (spayed) young cats.



Composition

Dried animal protein from chicken, hydrolysed animal protein from chicken, pea starch, animal fat from chicken, rice, potato starch, dried marine protein from fish, dried krill (Euphausia superba), hydrolysed marine protein from salmon, lignocellulose, dried beet pulp, fish oil, calcium carbonate, fructo-oligosaccharides (FOS), beta-glucans from yeast, yucca extract, rosemary.

Appetitt Kitten can be served with free access according to your cat's appetite. It can also be served during gestation and lactation.

The feeding guidelines provides a guide on how much Appetitt Kitten to feed your cat each day. Food requirements may vary depending on the individual cat and level of activity, so keep an eye on your kitten's needs and adjust the amount of food accordingly. Always remember to ensure free access to fresh water. The food should be stored in a cool, dry place.
